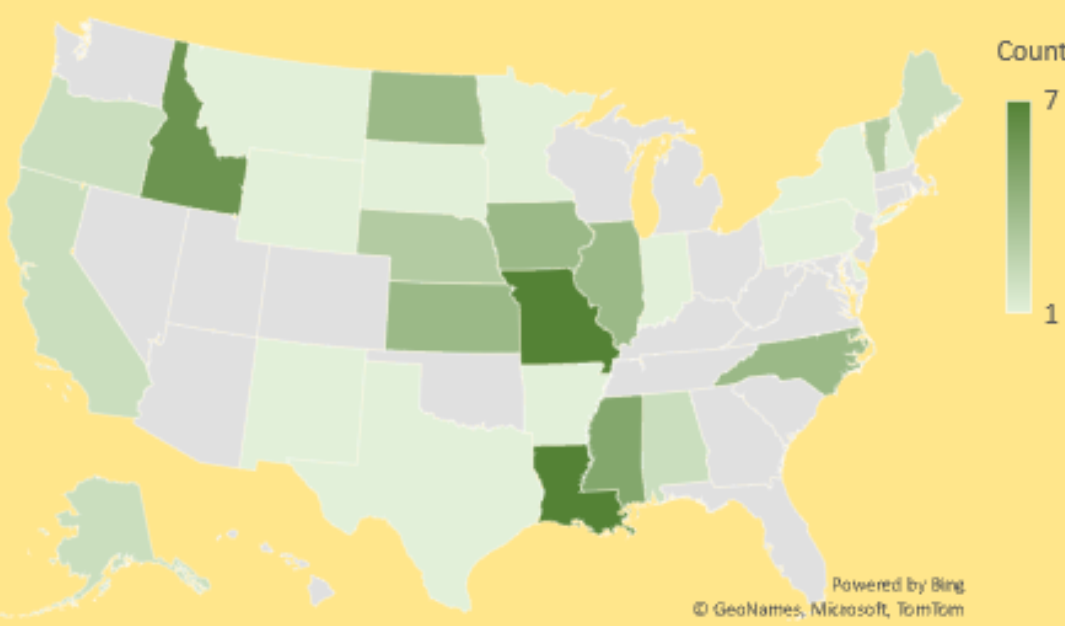

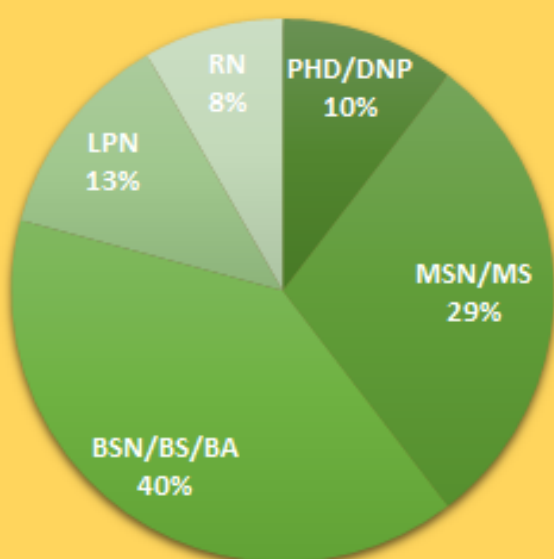


From 2018 to 2020 the Nurse Scholar program has had participants from across the country.

Encompassing 29 of the 50 US states, and even a few international participants.

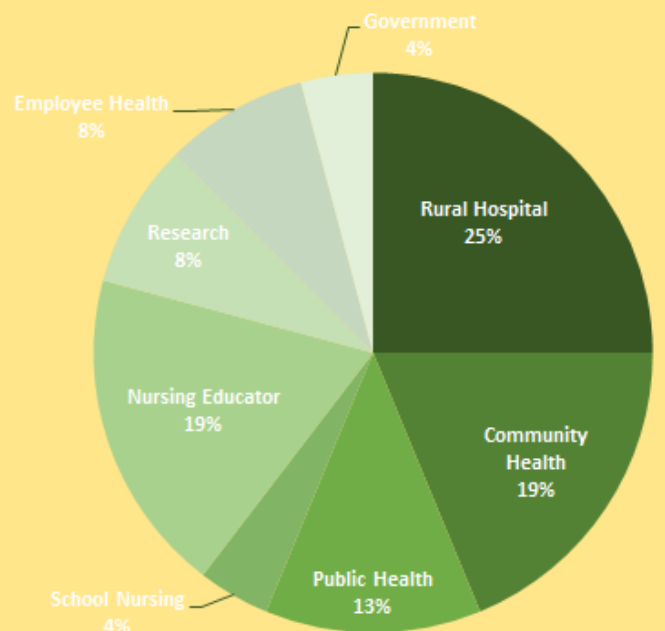
## DEGREE DIVERSITY
